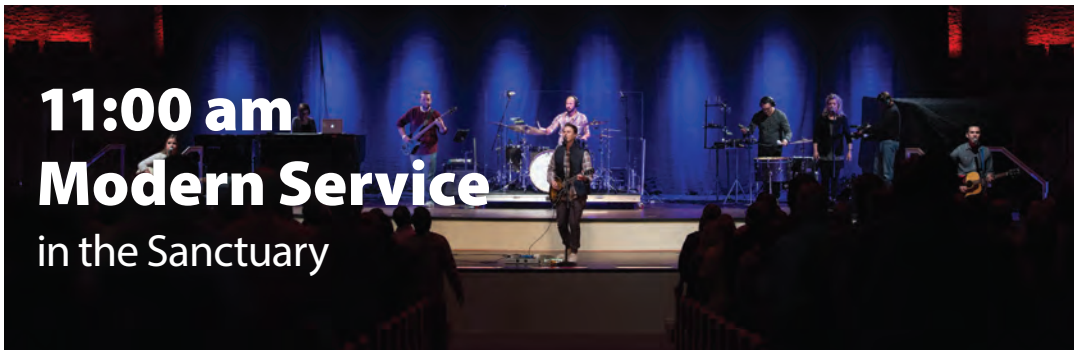

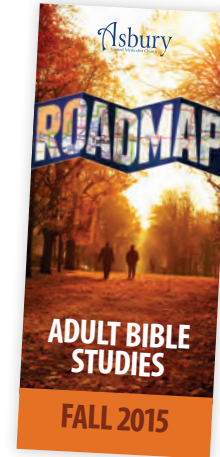

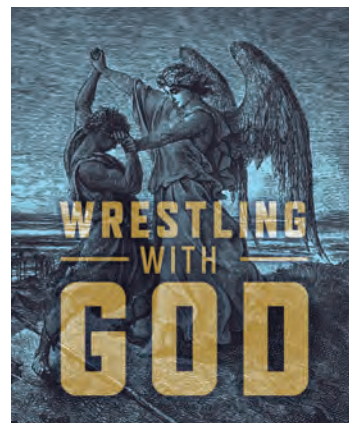
Online registration is open for adult discipleship classes. Go to www.myasburytulsa.org for details on cost and dates.
