It's sure to be an exciting day! We'd be honored if you would join us. Visit the Community Life Center (CLC) to find out where you can get plugged in.




9:30-12:30 Check-in tables open 10:30-12:30 Lunch in CLC or Gym

3. Schedule to join.


Join on New Member Sunday, which is normally the second Sunday of each month.
