Discipleship Pathway Meeting for Communities TONIGHT

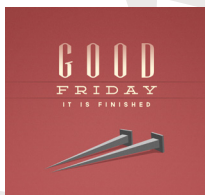
6:00–7:00 in Mason Chapel

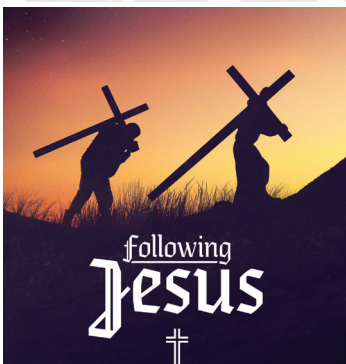
