

She began helping with the 5 and 6-yearolds and then moved to the 3 and 4-year olds. She has no preference for the age she teaches as, according to her, *each age is amazing!* 



The older children catch on to things quick, and everything is

new and exciting to the younger ones. Her own kids think it's neat to have Mommy in there! CJ likes the Alpha/Omega structure, which is set up for the entire school year. She volunteers the first two Sundays at 9:15 and has the second two Sundays off. She thinks this is good as it allows the volunteers to have some flexibility.

When CJ was first asked to volunteer, she was hesitant to accept. She didn't really want to "babysit" on Sunday morning and give up her personal time to really connect


