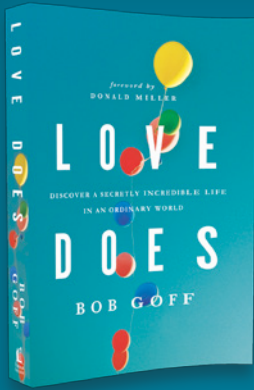
Sunday Morning Worship 9:15 am and 11 am, August 7
