# Love Check-Up

*“And now I will show you the most excellent way. These three things remain: faith, hope and love. But the greatest of these is love.”* 1 Corinthians 12:31b, 13:13

So you think you are doing pretty well in the love category? Let’s take a close and possibly painful look at what God really means by the word “love” in 1 Corinthians 13.

- Love is patient.** Love realizes its own character flaws and asks God’s grace to cover the faults of others.
- Love is kind.** Love looks for ways to give joy to others without expecting any recognition in return.
- Love does not envy.** Love encourages others to reach their full potential.
- Love does not boast.** Love seeks to glorify God over self. Love does not care if it gets credit or reward.
- Love is not proud.** Love does not make sarcastic remarks or put others down.
- Love is not rude.** Love respects others.
- Love is not self-seeking.** Love does not desire control. Love never insists on its own way. Love does not use others for self-promotion.
- Love is not easily angered.** Love is not touchy, irritated or resentful.
- Love keeps no record of wrongs.** Love overlooks the faults of others.
- Love does not delight in evil.** Love is never happy with sin or injustice. Love doesn’t gossip.
- Love rejoices with the truth.** Love makes a priority of spiritual things over selfish and destructive things.
- Love always protects.** Love always supports and understands.
- Love always trusts.** Love is ready to believe the best.
- Love always hopes.** Love has perfect peace in God who is in control.
- Love always perseveres.** Love never runs out.
- Love never fails.** Love is committed to obedience to God.

Are we loving like God loves? If not, confess it as sin and receive forgiveness (1 John 1:9). This kind of love is impossible on our own, but it is possible through the power of the Holy Spirit.
