AsburyKids

Kindergarten - 2nd Grade Volunteers at 11 am - Serving kindergarten through 2nd graders by playing with them, assisting with a lesson and craft provided, and getting to know them by leading a small group time.

3rd-5th Grade Volunteers at 11 am - Serving 3rd – 5th graders by playing with them, assisting with a lesson and craft provided, and getting to know them by leading a small group time.

Special Needs Volunteers at 9:15 and 11 am - The volunteer will "shadow" the child and encourage and guide participation to help the child have a successful Sunday morning.

Hospitality

11 am Hosts - Personally greet guests as they walk through the Sanctuary doors and make them feel welcome. Hosts will also hand out bulletins and collect offering.

11 am Greeters (Alpha) - Warmly welcome every person as they enter the doors of Asbury.

11 am Guest Services Desk - Greet guests warmly, answer questions they may have and provide information about our church.
