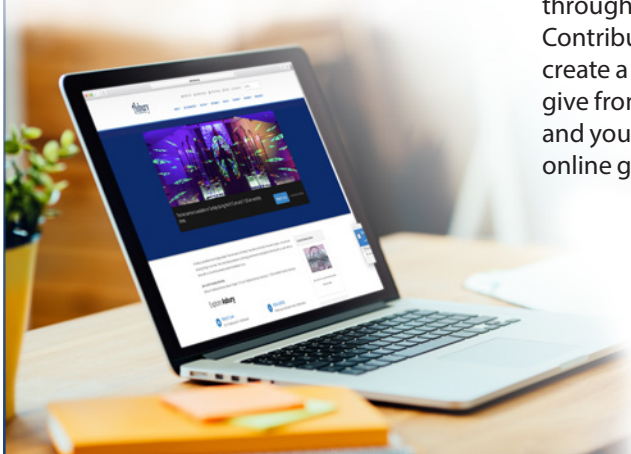

On **Sunday, April 23**, Asbury is kicking off a new global outreach initiative with special focus on the Syrian refugee crisis. We are building bridges with Syrian and Lebanese churches to take part in a disciple-making movement and partnering with World Vision to help provide life-changing support for refugees. World Vision vice president Steve Haas will be sharing in all services, and we will be giving our congregation practical opportunities to respond.
