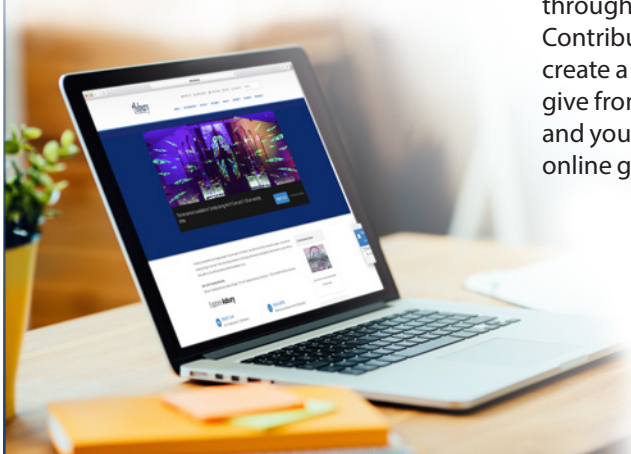

## April 20-23

We are excited to be launching a new global focus area to those displaced by the Syrian war. We are partnering long-term with the **Kinship Network**, a group of churches in North America and fellow believers in Lebanon and Syria, who are working in the context of this crisis.
