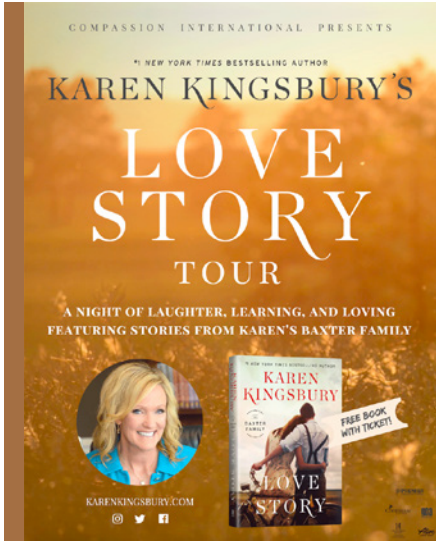
10th Annual Restore Hope Sunday

Your generous monetary contributions give Restore Hope wholesale buying power at the Community Food Bank. Your gifts also support Restore Hope's other programs to help families out of their current crisis and onto a path of economic vitality. Your timely contribution will also help alleviate the summer hunger crisis.

- One in four Oklahoma children is at risk of going to bed hungry
- 60 percent of all client households are "extremely low income" and well under the poverty line
- Last year, Restore Hope Ministries gave more than 221,943 lbs of food to more than 4,000 families
- Restore Hope kept 612 families from becoming homeless (at 100 percent success rate, they are one of the most successful in homelessness prevention in the nation)
- 504 Bibles were given away
- More than half of those assisted by Restore Hope are children under 18 years of age
- In 2016 – Asbury raised more than \$70,000
