Bibles and Blessings Celebration Today in Worship!

Today, Asbury is giving Bibles to the children who are in kindergarten through 3rd grade. Discipleship is very important to us and providing a Bible at this age gives them the chance to start reading and learning scripture at an early age. We recognize the strong relationships in the family. Parents are expected to provide opportunities for the child's faith development. However, there is a role for the church to play, too. The church's role is to train and empower kids and parents as they learn to follow Jesus together. Bible reading is one of the most important ways of becoming a knowledgeable follower of Christ.

Holy Communion Explained for Kids (and Grown-ups!)

Holy Communion is one of the oldest and most special traditions of the church. When we eat the bread and drink the juice, we are doing what Jesus and His disciples did 2,000 years ago! Everyone who follows Jesus has been sharing in the Lord's Supper since that day.

This is what happens during Communion:

- 1. **Prepare the Meal:** First, we set the table and announce that Jesus wants everybody to come have dinner at His house.
- 2. A Big Thank You: Just as Jesus gave thanks for the meal during the Last Supper, our pastors lead us in saying thanks to God. We ask God to put the Spirit of Jesus on the bread and juice, so that when we take them we are united with Him.
- 3. Breaking the Bread: Jesus said Communion should remind us of Him and His great love. When we break the bread and lift up the cup, we remember that Jesus gave up everything to show us a better way.
- 4. Dinner Time: If you love Jesus and want to follow Him, you are invited to this meal. When we receive Holy Communion, we are getting a sneak peek at God's great heavenly feast which we will all enjoy when Jesus returns.

How to Receive Communion:

- 1. When the ushers release your row, you may (if you choose) come forward.
- 2. The server will say, "This is the body of Christ, given for you." Cup your hands and hold them out to the server. A good way to respond is, "Amen" or "Thanks be to God."
- 3. The second server will say, "This is the blood of Christ, shed for you." Here, you dip the bread into the juice, and then you may eat it. Again, you may say, "Amen" or "Thanks be to God."
- **4.** At this point, you may return to your seat or kneel at the chancel rail and spend a few minutes in prayer.

Excerpt from the Sermon Journal, Monday, August 14, 2017 Written by Pastor Tom Harrison

"Resolve" is "a resolution, determination, steadfastness, grit, tenacity, doggedness, firmness and/or persistence." Resolve makes a decision or takes a stand. As we study Daniel and his Jewish friends living in exile in Babylon, we

see what a difference taking a godly stand can make. They had impeccable credentials, while many others in the Bible showed resolve but had some serious lapses: Abraham, Moses, David, Solomon, Hezekiah, Elijah, John the Baptist and Peter. We love the uncompromising resolve of Joseph, Ruth, Hannah, Mordecai and Esther, Jeremiah, Isaiah, Nehemiah, Paul and Jesus. Whether we have lapses or stay true to the end, we all have influence. Let's make ours count.
